## MHT Acquires Dyer Memorial

The [Muskoka Heritage Trust](http://www.muskokaheritage.org) is now the custodian of the Dyer Memorial in Huntsville, a 155-acre property consisting of 1,800 feet of undisturbed shoreline habitat along the Big East River, a two-acre private cemetery with a 42-foot monument, deer and moose wintering areas and an oxbow pond. The property has been certified Ecologically Sensitive through Environment Canada's Ecogift Program.
