- Ontario Stewardship Program










Ontario Stewardship (Background Cont.)

- Est. 1994
- Private Lands Stewardship & Southern Ontario
- Approx. 40 Individual Stewardship Councils/Networks
 - 12-14 Members from varying backgrounds



- "Seed Money" provided
- Collaboration, Cooperation, and Partner Delivery
- Work of each Council/Network unique to geographic area "community approach."







Accomplishments of OS (2008/2009)

- Raised \$18,000,000 in project contributions
 - (1:5 for every dollar invested by MNR, community partnerships yielded a \$5 project investment)
- Engaged 3,195 stewardship partners
- Completed 574 community-driven projects
- Hosted 660 education events attended by more than 170,000 people.
- We're moving "North" with the establishment of 6 new councils (ex. Manitoulin Island, North Bay, Kenora, Sault St. Marie)


