


INTEGRA Bespoke Lighting

As urban sprawl has continued to grow, so has the pollution of the night sky with artificial light.




In the United States, it is estimated that 1.5 billion dollars per year is spent on wasted light directed into the night sky.

BRIGHT LIGPROBLEMS

Note how glare travels across the surface of the lake.

Glare from unshielded fixtures along shorelines is particularly insidious.

By making use of "Full Cut Off" fixtures, designers are now able to greatly reduce light pollution and increase efficiency.




New "Cutoff" Style

Old Style Streetlight


New fixture designs and lamp technology are now available which greatly reduce light pollution levels.

New municipal regulations requiring the use of "Dark Sky Friendly" lighting systems are having a big impact. **Commercial Properties** have traditionally been some of the largest contributors to "Sky Glow".





These are two examples of full cut off fixtures for use on residential properties.Note that you cannot see the source of light.



Scientists estimate that in the United States alone 100 million birds are killed every year by crashing into windows or from exhaustion after becoming confused while trying to navigate by artificial lights instead of the the stars.

By using smaller, full cut off fixtures you are able to put just enough light precisely where it is required, eliminating light trespass and glare.



Notice 2 Things... More light where it is needed And virtually no glare is produced. Bonus: The owner is now using less electricity!



Not only is this type of lighting wasteful and unattractive, it is also ineffective. Glare hampers the ability of the eye to see.



Aiming floodlights out into your yard? You might want to re-aim them down and increase the level of security around your property while making it more visually appealing to guests.
